



9th ALGOA & 4th GAOD Summits

-Manifesting Organic Districts in Asia-

June 5th to 6th, 2023 / Kauswagan, Lanao de Norte, Philippines

1. Rationale of the Theme

In 2020, the success of the growth of organic districts in Europe and the strengthening of cooperation among like-minded organizations such as the International Network of Eco-regions, Asian Local Governments for Organic Agriculture, Regeneration International, etc., culminated in the creation of the “Global Alliance of Organic Districts (GAOD)”.

Since then, the annual ALGOA & GAOD Summits have recorded and disseminated best practices under the 7 Working Groups of GAOD. The virtual Summits have gathered attention from more than 35 countries with an average of 800 attendees during the sessions.

The two years since the consolidation of GAOD have also seen the finalization of the Toolkits that can be used to design and accomplish similar organic districts anywhere in the world.

The time is ripe for ALGOA under its new leadership of Mayor Rommel Arnado of Kauswagan and as the head of the League of Organic Agriculture Municipalities, Cities, & Provinces (LOAMCP), to consider the holistic development of organic agriculture based on the concept of organic districts.

2. Significance of the Philippines taking on the leadership of ALGOA

1. Working with LOAMCP

Undoubtedly, the existence of the League of Organic Agriculture Municipalities, Cities, Provinces (LOAMCP) in the Philippines is of vital importance for the future growth of ALGOA.

LOAMCP has more than 150 local governments participating as members, and this constitutes almost half of the ALGOA membership. Under the charismatic leadership of Mayor Rommel Arnado, the network of elected mayors and governors is growing steadily.

Furthermore, many of the elected officers are young and eager to implement organic agriculture practices and ALGOA can make an impact through organizing leadership capacity-building programs, policy-oriented workshops, networking, etc.

Initial contact has already been made with some newly-elected mayors who have agreed to the proposal on the formation of the “Young Elected Officers Network (YEON)” under ALGOA. A short training program proposal is being drafted as a first step. ALGOA-YEON is expected to be formally launched at the upcoming Summit in June.

2. Participatory Guarantee Systems (PGS) under Implementation as Part of National Organic Regulations

One of the biggest achievements for IFOAM, was the inclusion of PGS as part of the national organic regulations. It was 5 years of advocacy that led to the ratification by the Senate of the Philippines in 2020.

The successful implementation of PGS will be an example to other countries and ALGOA and IFOAM will continue to assist the relevant government agencies.

3. New ALGOA Presidency: Kauswagan, Lanao del Norte - “From Arms to Farms: Walking through the Paths of Peace”

Since the 1970s, Kauswagan was the center of decades-long conflict between local insurgencies and the military with the poverty rate at an all-record high of 90%.

In 2010, a new local government under the charismatic leadership of Mayor Rommel Arnado started to address the root causes of the conflict, which were found to be poverty, food insecurity and inequalities between population groups. The project ‘**From Arms to Farms: Walking through the Paths of Peace**’ was implemented to help former combatants to reintegrate into society while at the same time addressing the food security problem. These combatants agreed to lay down their arms in exchange for farm materials and a decade later, they have become the most exemplary organic farmer leaders in the municipality. **The poverty rate has decreased to 20% levels.**

For its efforts, Kauswagan was awarded with the **UCLG Peace Prize** in October 2016 and the **Honorable Mention of the Future Policy Award** in 2018 from the World Future Council and IFOAM-Organics International.
